One of my favorites is the sweet snack tiny cherry tomato. These grew from fruits that fell in the pot last year! They make a sweet bite size garnish for salads. Cucumbers have been great this year, the trick was making sure the ground didn't dry out too much. Another hit this year was the cherry pepper. They are compact little fruits that pack a spicy punch but not too much. I believe they originate in Eastern Europe (Hungary).
