

Autumn Rose...last of the season



This is from a variety of rose called Voodoo. The color starts as a bright salmon color and changes to a dark rose color. Sometimes, in the right light (twilight or sunrise) the blooms almost look like they are glowing. I have the Abraham Lincoln variety too. That starts out a velvety red that changes to almost a black tinged shade.



Here is a shot of the three types of tomato and one pepper that grew in the garden this year. Pictured are: Golden Harvest (yellow cherry tomato) Fourth of July (red jumbo cherry) and the tiny red Sweet Snack variety. Also pictured is the Hungarian Cherry Pepper.
